POLICY 443 – TUTORING OF STUDENTS

I. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to provide information to school district employees regarding parameters for tutoring students.

II. General Statement of Policy

The school district recognizes that some students benefit from tutoring. School district employees are uniquely qualified to provide students with these services. School district employees may provide tutoring services for students consistent with this policy and the Code of Ethics for Minnesota Teachers.

III. Providing Tutoring Services

- A. The school district community education department will provide tutoring services on a district wide basis.
- B. The school district community education department may employ school district teachers or other qualified employees to tutor school district students provided that the tutoring work does not interfere with the performance of the employee's duties.
- C. A teacher may not receive a fee for any tutoring done through the school district's community education program during the teacher's duty day or on school district property unless specifically authorized to do so by the superintendent or designee.
